New sale of an EMEW® plant

Electrometals Technologies is pleased to announce that the company has been commissioned to supply an EMEW® copper plating plant to a customer in the United States. The plant will recover copper from an electrolyte stream processed through an IX (ion exchange) plant, part of a more complex plant to recover precious and base metals from slag material remaining from former smelting operations.

The value of this sale is \$465,000, for delivery in the second quarter of 2008. A substantial deposit has been received.

Kurion Technologies order book

Electrometals is also able to report that several sales for differing environmental solutions have been secured so far this year to mid-March 2008 by Kurion Technologies (owned 51% by Electrometals) in the UK. Approximately £750,000 or some A\$1,650,000 of anticipated revenue from this order book, to be derived from ongoing work in hand, is expected to be included in the consolidated revenue of the group.
