BUSINESS UPDATE

Directors are pleased to announce that the company has secured a contract worth \$321,700 for the sale of an EMEW® electrowinning plant to the Enami El Salado mine in Chile. An official purchase order has been issued by Enami and a substantial deposit is due to be paid shortly.

Enami is owned by the Chilean government and processes minerals for many mining operations, with an emphasis on providing processing facilities for small to medium scale miners. The plant is the second stage expansion of the EMEW® electrowinning facility at El Salado, the first stage having been delivered in 2008. The plant is used for the production of copper cathode from the bleed stream from the existing, conventional electrowinning (EW) plant, part of a solvent extraction – electrowinning (SX-EW) facility to recover high-grade copper metal from a heap leach operation.
